Family Research Council presents our vote scorecard for the 107th Congress. This scorecard contains a compilation of significant votes representing a cross-section of issues affecting the family that occurred in the U.S. House of Representatives during the Second Session of the 107th Congress in 2002, and votes that occurred in the U.S. Senate during the entire 107th Congress (2001 and 2002).

This scorecard serves as an important tool in showing you how your elected officials voted on some of the most important issues facing the family. It is important to remember, however, that the votes you see here are only a few of the hundreds of recorded votes which members of the House of Representatives took in 2002 and members of the Senate took during the two year period spanning 2001 and 2002. With this in mind, we have tried to single out for inclusion the most clear-cut, pro-family and anti-family votes that came before Members of Congress.

This scorecard marks the end of the 107th Congress but it does not mark the end of our work on the issues explained inside. Our efforts to defend and protect faith, family and freedom continue. While we maintain a constant watch of what is taking place in our nation's capitol, we rely upon you, informed and active constituents, to work with us in contacting your members of Congress on pro-family issues. There is no greater asset in the battle to preserve the American family than an informed and involved citizenry. Thank you for choosing to be involved; we can't do it without you.

SENATE MEMBERSHIP CHANGES DURING THIS SESSION

James Jeffords (I-VT) Changed his party affiliation to Independent on June 5, 2001.

1 Protecting the Civil Rights of Americans

Offered by Representative Henry Hyde (R-IL), this amendment (H.AMDT.418 to H.R. 2356) would prevent any section of the Bipartisan Campaign Finance Reform Act from being construed to abridge the freedoms found in the First Amendment to the Constitution, specifically the freedom of speech or of the press, to peaceably assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances.

Failed 2/13/2002 FRC Supported this Amendment

2 Respecting Parental Notification and Consent Laws

Introduced by Representative Ileana Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL), the Child Custody Protection Act (H.R. 476) would amend Title 18 of the United States Code to prohibit taking minors across state lines in circumvention of laws requiring the involvement of parents in abortion decisions. This bill would ensure that state parental notification and consent laws were respected and enforced, reaffirming the role of parents in a minor's abortion decision.

Passed 4/17/2002 FRC Supported this Bill

3 Preventing Abortions in Military Hospitals

Offered by Representative Loretta Sanchez (D-CA), this amendment (H.AMDT.478 to H.R. 4546) would repeal current law prohibiting overseas U.S. military hospitals and medical clinics from performing privately-funded abortions for U.S. service members and their families.

Failed 5/10/2002 FRC Opposed this Amendment

4 Encouraging Marriage and Abstinence

Introduced by Representative Deborah Pryce (R-OH), the Personal Responsibility, Work, and Family Promotion Act (H.R. 4737) would continue funding for Title V, which provides funds for abstinence-only education programs in public schools. The bill would also fund marriage improvement programs, including pre- and post-marital counseling and relationship training courses for citizens on welfare.

Passed 5/16/2002 FRC Supported this Bill

5 Permanent Repeal of the Death Tax

Introduced by Representative Dave Weldon (R-FL), the Permanent Death Tax Repeal Act (H.R. 2143) would make permanent the repeal of the death tax contained in the 2001 Tax Relief Package.

Passed 6/6/2002 FRC Supported this Bill

6 Permanent Repeal of the Marriage Tax Penalty

Introduced by Representative Jerry Weller (R-IL),

H.R. 4019 would make permanent the marriage tax penalty relief provisions of the 2001 Tax Relief Package. **Passed 6/13/2002 FRC Supported this Bill**

7 Preventing Child Obscenity and Pornography

Introduced by Representative Lamar Smith (R-TX), the Child Obscenity and Pornography Prevention Act (H.R. 4623) would prevent trafficking in child pornography and obscenity and prevent the use of child pornography and obscenity to facilitate crimes against children. This bill was in response to the Supreme Court's decision overturning the Child Pornography Prevention Act of 1996.

Passed 6/25/2002 FRC Supported this Bill

8 Decreasing Funding for the National Endowment for the Arts

Offered by Representative Tom Tancredo (R-CO), this amendment (H.AMDT.538 to H.R. 5093) would decrease funding for the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA). The NEA has consistently funded, produced, and distributed morally objectionable art that frequently included attacks on religion, traditional art forms, and families. The NEA has also been a forum for the promotion of homosexuality, pornography and other sexually explicit material.

Failed 7/17/2002 FRC Supported this Amendment

9 Allowing Partial-Birth Abortions

Offered by Representative Tammy Baldwin (D-WI), a procedural maneuver known as a "motion to recommit" the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act (H.R. 4965) would gut the bill by including a "health exception." The inclusion of a "health exception" would render a ban on partial-birth abortions ineffective because courts have interpreted "health exceptions" to include anything from acne to depression. This allowed representatives to vote against banning partial-birth abortions while appearing to support such a ban.

Failed 7/24/2002 FRC Opposed this Motion

10 Banning Partial-Birth Abortions

Introduced by Representative Steve Chabot (R-OH), the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act (H.R. 4965) would prohibit the procedure commonly known as partial-birth abortion. The bill also includes findings that challenge the evidence used by the Supreme Court in *Stenberg v. Carhart*, which legitimized partial-birth abortions, showing that partial-birth abortions are never necessary to preserve the health of the mother.

1 Promoting School Choice

Offered by Senator Judd Gregg (R-NH), this amendment (S.AMDT.536 to S. 1) would provide for a low-income school choice demonstration program. This program would fund studies concerning the relative success of private schools and public charter schools versus public schools in low-income areas.

Failed 6/12/2001 FRC Supported this Amendment

2 Encouraging Intellectual Freedom and Scientific Debate

Offered by Senator Rick Santorum (R-PA), this amendment (S.AMDT.799 to S. 1) would seek to better inform our nation's students regarding science education. Specifically, this amendment states that while students are taught about biological evolution, they should also be provided with information explaining different perspectives and why this subject generates continuing controversy.

Passed 6/13/2001 FRC Supported this Amendment

3 Protecting the Boy Scouts of America

Offered by Senator Jesse Helms (R-NC), this amendment (S.AMDT.648 to S. 1) would prohibit the distribution of federal funds to any state or local educational agency or school that discriminates against the Boy Scouts of America in providing equal access to school premises or facilities. This amendment prevents discrimination against the Boy Scouts of America for their policy regarding the employment or voluntary service of homosexual troop leaders.

Passed 6/14/01 FRC Supported this Amendment

4 Protecting Freedom of Speech

The Campaign Finance Reform Act (H.R. 2356) would limit the freedom of speech of Americans with regard to political campaigns. The bill would ban all contributions of "soft money," and impose severe restrictions on issue advocacy communications. The bill was signed into law March 27, 2002 (P.L. 107-155).

Passed 3/20/2002 FRC Opposed this Bill

5 Supporting a Fair and Impartial Judiciary

Offered by Senator Trent Lott (R-MS), this amendment (S.AMDT.3033 to S. 517) would provide for the fair treatment of presidential judicial nominees by pressing the Senate Judiciary Committee to hold hearings for nominees to positions on Circuit, Appeals, and District Courts that are unable to process their caseloads due to judicial vacancies.

Failed 3/21/2002 FRC Supported this Amendment

6 Preventing the Establishment of Thought Crimes

FRC opposed a vote to send this bill to the floor for final passage. Introduced by Senator Edward Kennedy (D-MA), the Local Law Enforcement Enhancement Act (S. 625) or "hate crimes" bill would expand the jurisdiction of the federal government by giving it the power to interpret and classify certain speech, thought, theology, and moral belief as unlawful or contributing to crime. This bill would have a chilling effect on free speech.

Failed 6/11/2002 FRC Opposed this Motion

7 Permanent Repeal of the Death Tax

Offered by Senator Phil Gramm (R-TX), this amendment (S.AMDT.3833 to H.R. 8) would make permanent the repeal of the death tax contained in the 2001 Tax Relief Package.

Failed 6/12/2002 FRC Supported this Amendment

8 Prohibiting the Patenting of Human Clones

A vote to cut off debate effectively killed the amendment offered by Senator Sam Brownback (R-KS). This amendment (S.AMDT.3843 to S. 2600) would bar researchers from obtaining a patent on any form of human life produced through cloning.

Passed 6/18/2002 FRC Opposed this Motion

9 Preventing Abortions in Military Hospitals

Offered by Senators Olympia Snowe (R-ME) and Patty Murray (D-WA), this amendment (S.AMDT.3927 to S. 2514) would repeal current law prohibiting domestic and overseas U.S. military hospitals and medical clinics from performing privately-funded abortions for U.S. service members and their families.

Passed 6/21/2002 FRC Opposed this Amendment
