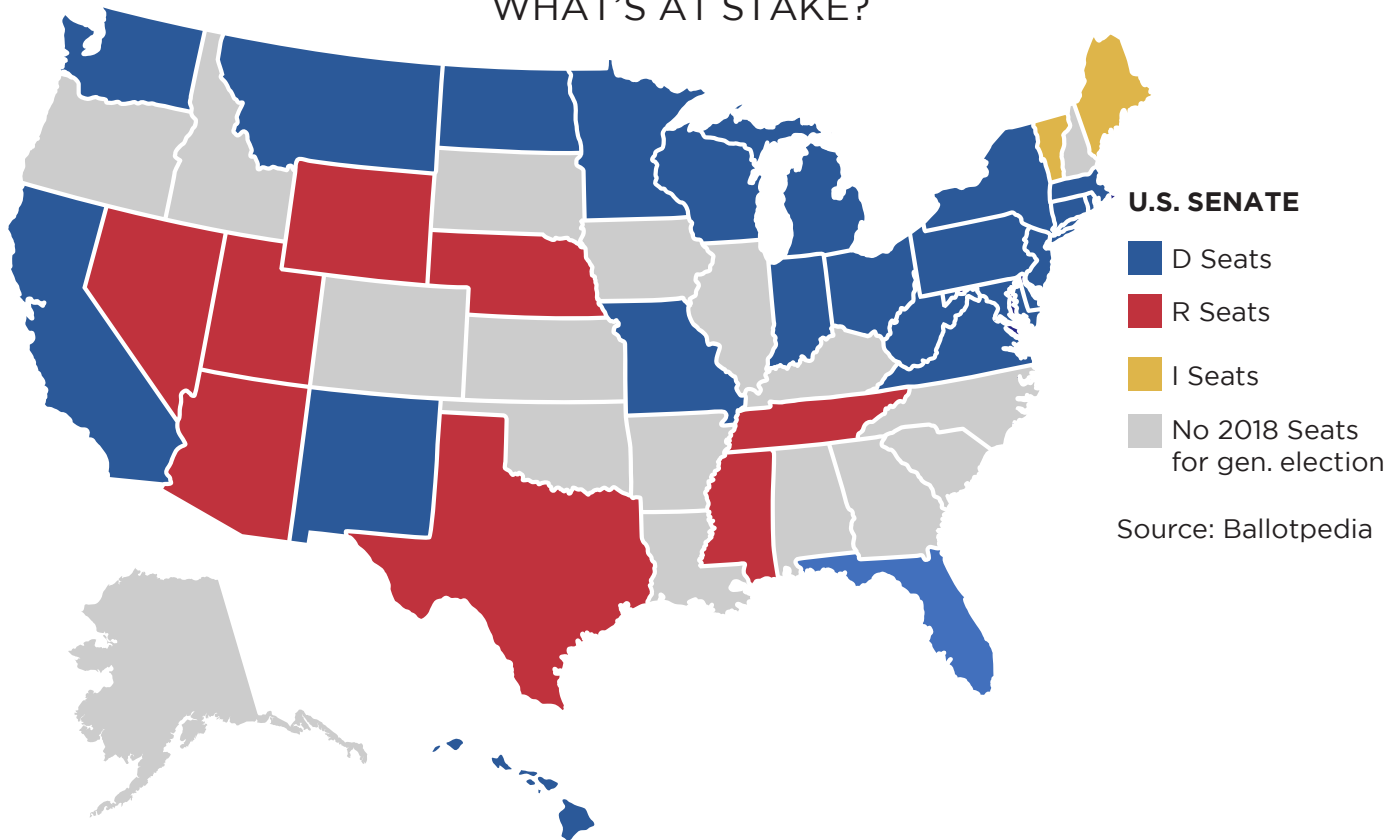


2018 MIDTERM ELECTIONS

WHAT'S AT STAKE?



SENATE SEATS OVERVIEW

35 senate seats are up for general election in 2018: 24 Democrats, 9 Republicans, and 2 Independents (that caucus with the Democrats). The GOP is currently holding 51 U.S. Senate seats. 10 of the Democrats' seats up in 2018 are in states President Trump won and only 1 GOP-held seat is in a state Hillary Clinton won. Obamacare repeal and Planned Parenthood defunding failed in the Senate by one vote. In addition to important legislation, there are many judicial vacancies as well as potential Supreme Court appointments that will be determined by the Senate.

THE BATTLE TO CONTROL REDISTRICTING

Right now the GOP controls 67 out of 99 state legislative chambers and 33 of 50 Governorships. States will undergo redistricting for both state and federal districts in 2020. In most states, the state legislature controls that process. Whoever controls redistricting will have a huge impact on who controls Congress for the next decade as well as their own state legislatures. The Left is mounting a strategic, organized, and well-funded effort to gain control of this process.

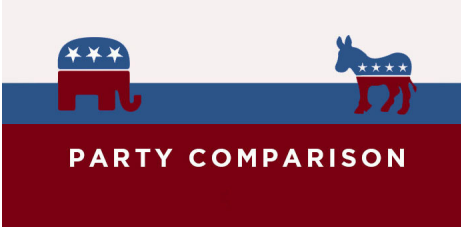
REGISTER TO VOTE

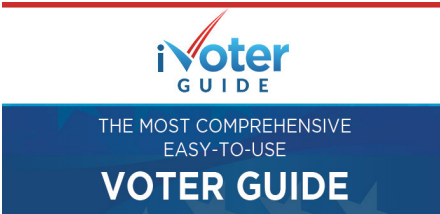

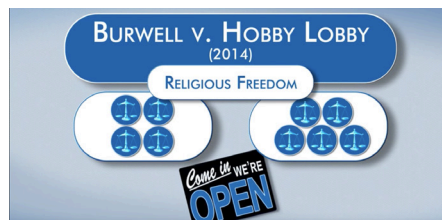
HELP US ADVANCE OUR VALUES IN 2018
